INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING PETITION FOR CERTIFICATE OF TITLE

The Court of Common Plea may issue an Order directing the Department of Transportation to issue a Certificate of Title to an individual following the presentation of a Petition for Certificate of Title which indicates to the Court:

1. The year/make of the vehicle in question
2. The VIN Number (Vehicle Identification Number)
3. How you came into possession of the vehicle and why you believe the vehicle should be titled to you.
4. Averments that the vehicle is not the subject of any civil liens or judgments; not subject to divorce proceedings involving equitable distribution and not a stolen vehicle or subject to any criminal investigations. The Court needs to be assured the vehicle is free and clear from any encumbrances.
5. Attached copies of any documentation which supports your claim to ownership i.e. bill of sale, will etc.
6. Fill out the Petition, clearly and legibly and file at the Wayne County Prothonotary's office and pay a filing fee of \$103.50.
7. Submit the Petition to the Court Administrator for the assignment of a hearing date.
8. Once the date is fixed it is your responsibility to send a copy of the petition and scheduling Order to the last known previous owner so that individual has an opportunity to address the Court.
9. Appear at the hearing, indicate again to the Court your reasons for the issuance of a title and if the Court finds your argument persuasive, the Court will sign the attached Order directing PennDOT to issue you the title.
10. You obtain a certified copy of the Order from the Prothonotary's office and take same to any licensing service to effect the application for title. You will be responsible for any additional fees associated with the application process.
